Q1: What is a SurfStation?

ANS: A SurfStation is a modified computer that allows the user to:

- Send and Receive e-mail
- Find a Job
- Improve the Community
- Make Money
- Purchase Low-Cost Prescriptions
- Access Homework Assignments
- Perform Online Research
- View Medical Information
- Become a Part of the Information Age

The SurfStation is a Pentium⁰ class computer that has been reconfigured to perform ONE function... To provide inexpensive access to the full Power of the Internet!

Q2: How much does it cost?

ANS: SurfStations are available for a one-time cost of \$150.

Q2: What is included with my SurfStation? What do I get?

ANS: You get a Pentium class CPU with modem, keyboard, mouse, monitor, and a power strip. Also included in this \$150 price is a one-year subscription for 365 hours of Internet access * .

Q3: Is The SurfStation easy to setup?

ANS: Setting up a SurfStation requires only the most basic skills. After locating the SurfStation on a suitable surface.

- 1) Plug one end of the CPU power cord into the proper plug on the back of the SurfStation and the other end into the included power strip.
- 2) Plug the monitor into the connector into the back of the SurfStation
- 3) Plug in the mouse and Keyboard connector into the back of the SurfStation
- 4) Turn on the SurfStation.
- 5) The SurfStation will automatically connect to the Internet.

Q3: Is The SurfStation easy to use?

ANS: Users of the SurfStation access the Internet through the included browser software that allows easy and seamless entry to the information superhighway.

Q5: Is The SurfStation broadband capable?

ANS: YES! All SurfStations are broadband ready. Plug your SurfStation into a hub connected to a DHCP network, and the SurfStation will automatically connect to your Internet ready Local Area Network. SurfStation are an inexpensive way to expand your in-home broadband LAN.
